



BEHAVIOUR, CHOICES AND MARKETS

Applications are invited for a number of 3-year PhD studentships within the University of Aberdeen Business School, in two waves: three studentships starting October 2010 and four studentships starting October 2011. The majority of studentships will be led by Economics under the theme *Behaviour, Choices and Markets*. In the last RAE the Economics group had 20% of its research rated as 4* (World Leading), 45% as 3* (Internationally Excellent) and 35% as 2* (Recognised Internationally).

The available studentships are:

- Two PhD studentships exploring Energy Markets;
- Two PHD studentships in Experimental Economics utilising the Scottish Experimental Economics Laboratory (SEEL);
- Two PhD awards within Labour Market Economics;
- A one year Masters in Research (MRes) with a view to a PhD (starting 2011) investigating International Property Investment;
- Two further MRes (2011-12) and (2012-13) in Management Studies.

The studentships are open to all nationalities and will cover home/EU or Overseas fees. Deadline for applications (for entry October 2010) is 21st May 2010.
