Author affiliation	Handling of authors organisation affiliation who have moved to the University and wish to keep that relationship associated with the output.
CV Module – Available October 2010	Allow the easy creation of a CV
Data quality management	De-duplication of external persons and organisations
	De-duplication of Journal/publisher
	Merge publications: To allow better management of duplicate research output
	Ability to check existing journals/publishers and not create duplicates when adding new research output content
	Ability to search and choose from existing list of external authors.
Export options – Available October 2010	Endnote included as an export option
Group author	Improvements to how group author is handled and displayed on publications
Library functionality – Available October 2010	Sherpa/Romeo integration; In relation to uploading documents to the Institutional Repository
REF module	Provide functionality for REF processes
Relations between research outputs	The ability to relate a publication to another e.g. working paper to journal article

Reports	Improvements to pre-defined reports
Scanning service – Available October 2010	Allow an individual to setup a scanning service which will then notify them when a new record is available for self import from an external source such as Web of Science
Self import options	Scopus will become available as a self import source
Student Information (Postgraduate Research Student)	Student information should be displayed in staff profile using synchronisation from University Student Record system
Workflow	Improving the workflow process
WoS Improvement	WoS Self import improvement to allow the automatching of external persons and organisations to entries already held in Pure
