Research outputs transferred from old Publications database	<p>Due to the layout of our old Publications database we have been unable to map all content in Pure to the correct field, e.g. Publishers and place of publication for chapters in books.</p> <p>It is our intention that the Library will work through these but this is a large task that will take some time to complete, therefore, we request that where possible you make corrections to your content whenever you come across this type of error.</p>
Research outputs purchased from Thomson Reuters	<p>We have purchased from Thomson Reuters around 3,500 additional records, mostly relating to journal articles, to top up our old data. Using electronic methods and manual, we have tried to match the correct internal authors to these records. We appreciate your patience if you come across entries in your personal list which have been wrongly attributed to you. At this stage in testing there is little point trying to correct these as corrections will not be retained in the live system, but once the system goes live we would ask that you do one of the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Where there are other internal authors on the publication please remove your name from the author list, using the minus sign next to your name. 2. Where you are the sole author on the publication use the delete button to remove the record.
Research outputs	Title not retaining some formatting e.g. symbols not displaying correctly in the list view
Author Initials	<p>You may come across instances where some of an authors initials are not taken across when importing or are not visible when picking from a list of authors.</p> <p>If you wish to correct this for an individual publication, please do so using the edit button next to the individual's name.</p>
