

# Recycling Points

There are two Local Authority Recycling Points on campus, one is located at Crombie Johnston Halls of Residence, and the other is located at Hillhead Halls of Residence.

These Recycling Points are for domestic waste only and are to be used by students and residents living within the vicinity of the campus. **Please note that they should not be used for any University waste, this would be illegal and breach the requirements of the Duty of Care.**

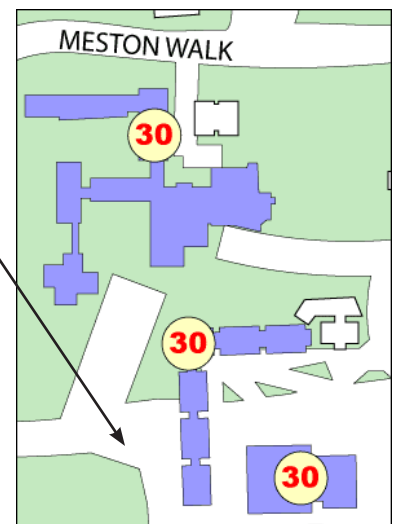
The Recycling Points are open all year round and should be used between the hours of 8am to 8pm to avoid unnecessary disturbance to neighbours.

The Recycling Points accept:

- Paper and Cardboard;
- Rinsed plastic bottles with the lids removed;
- Rinsed food and drinks cans; and
- Rinsed brown, green and clear glass.

Remember to keep the three colours of glass separate. Mixed glass cannot be used for making new bottles. If you have a blue glass bottle, use the green glass container.

If any of the banks are contaminated with other waste streams, this prevents the waste from being recycled. Please ensure you segregate your waste accordingly.

There are also textiles recycling banks located at these Recycling Points which accept unwanted clothing which is of a good condition, helping to support the local charity, the New Hope Trust.
