This commitment will enable all students, staff and visitors of the University to use their purchasing power to provide producers with a regular income, as well as fair pay and conditions.

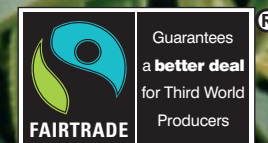
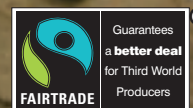
