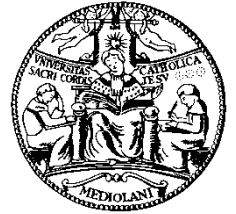

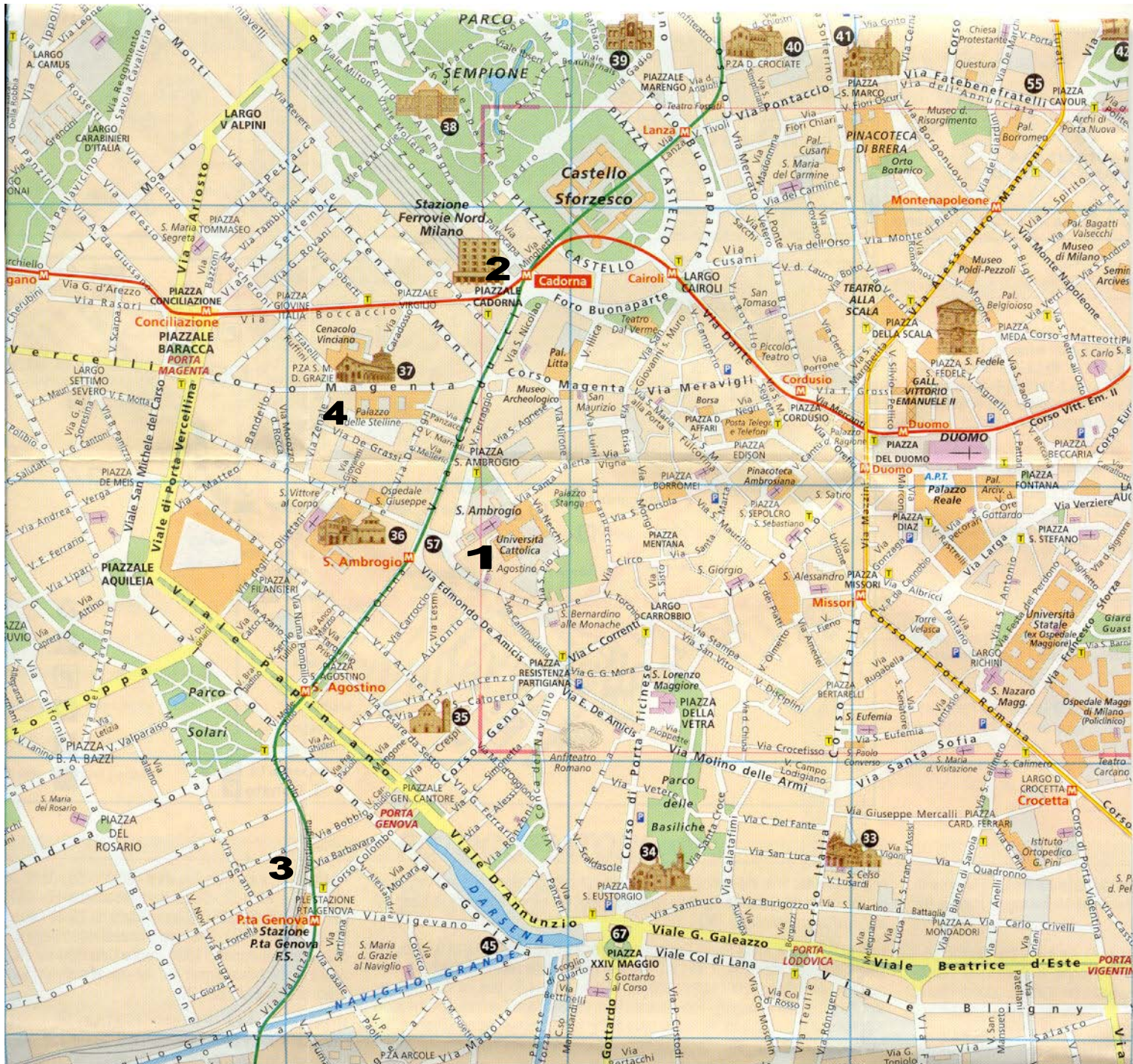
Travel

How to reach the conference venue (Università Cattolica, Largo Gemelli, 1 – Milano):

- **From the railway station** (Stazione Centrale F.S.), take the underground line 2 ("green line"), direction "Romolo". The sixth stop is S. Ambrogio Station, get out of the underground and go towards the Cathedral. Leave the Cathedral on your right and walk straight for about five minutes; on your right you will see the University main entrance (Gemelli Square, nr. 1). **By taxi:** 20 min. €20,00 approx.
- **From Orio al Serio Airport:** take the Coach to the railway station Stazione Centrale F.S. (for further information: www.sacbo.it/Airpor/portalProcess.jsp). **By taxi:** 1h 30 min. €150,00 approx.
- **From Linate Airport:** take Bus nr. 73 to piazza (square) S. Babila, then take the underground line 1 ("red line") to piazza (square) Cadorna (see below). **By taxi:** 30 min. €25,00 approx.
- **From piazza (square) Cadorna:** take via (street) Carducci. When you the crossing take via (street) Terraggio. Follow it to the end, on your left you will see the University main entrance (piazza, square Gemelli nr. 1). **By taxi:** 5 min. €6,00 approx.
- **From Malpensa Airport:** take the railway shuttle to Cadorna Station.
(For further information: www.sea-aeroportimilano.it/it/malpensa/) **By taxi:** 45 min. €85,00 (ask for fix rate).
