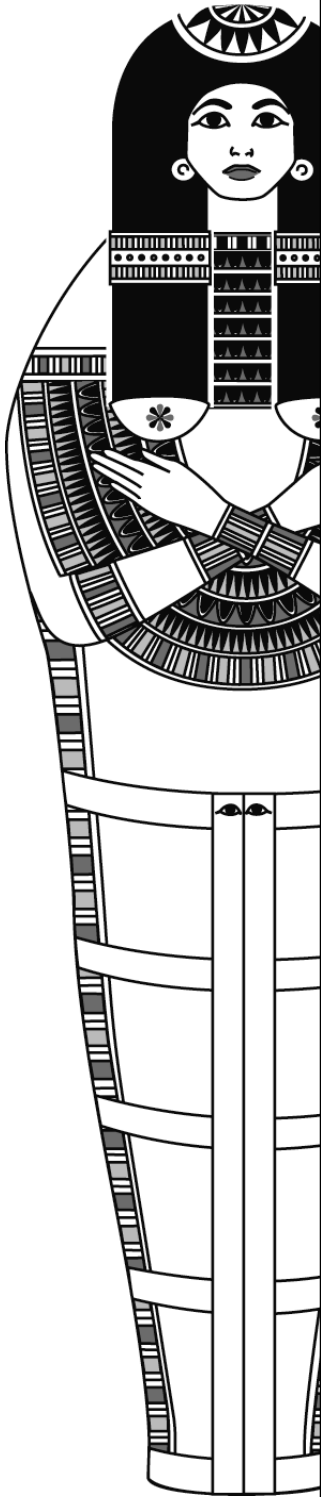

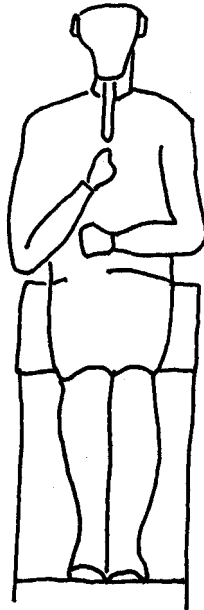

Statues of Osiris show him wearing a **crown** and holding a **crook** and a **flail** to show he was a pharaoh.

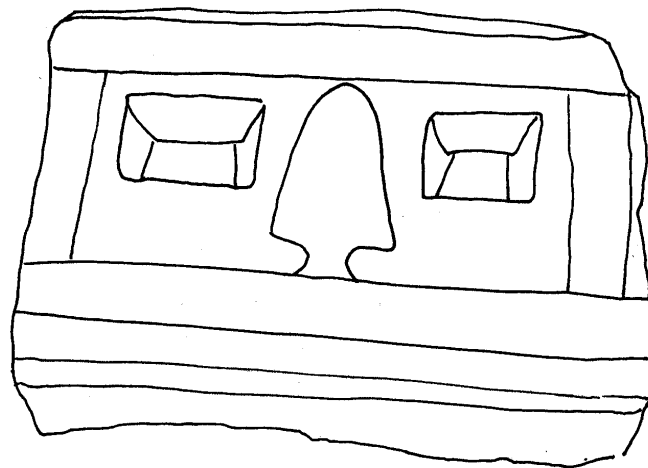
Find the statue of Osiris.



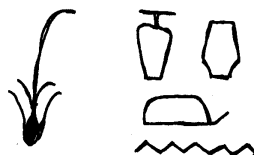
Copy the crown, crook and flail to this drawing.

Find this Offerings Table.



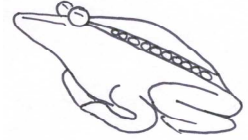
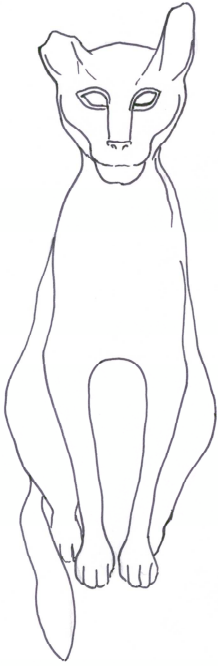
Food and drink were put in the hollows on the table when people wanted to ask the gods for help.

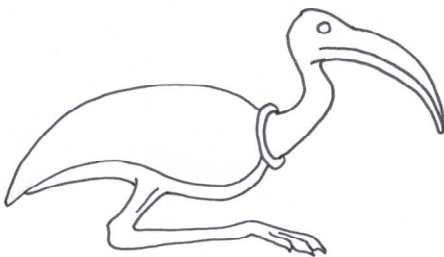

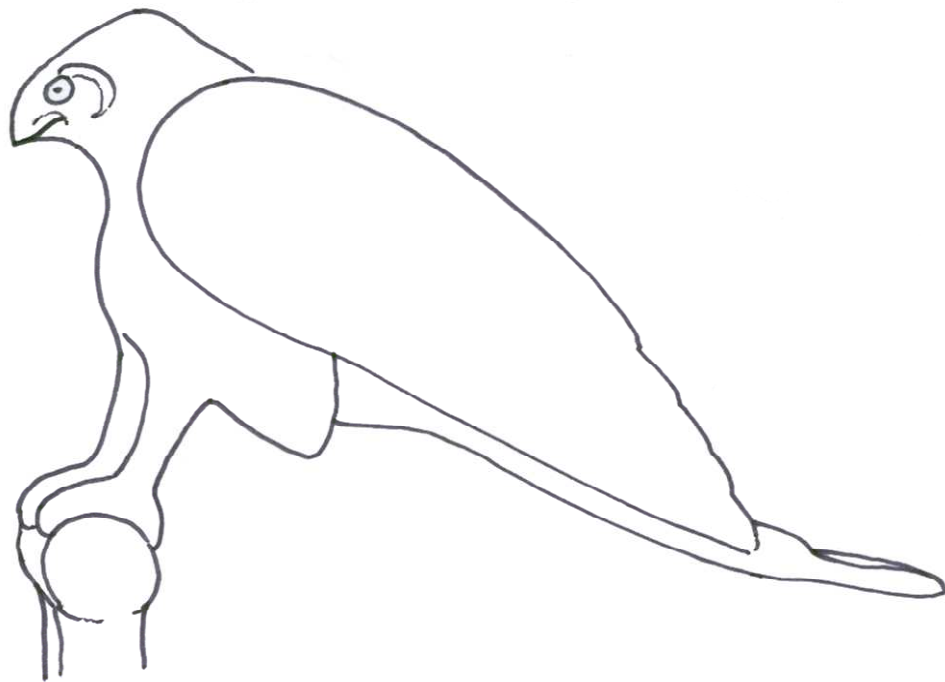
Why has the cat got a broken ear?

A sphinx had the body of a lion and the face of another creature.

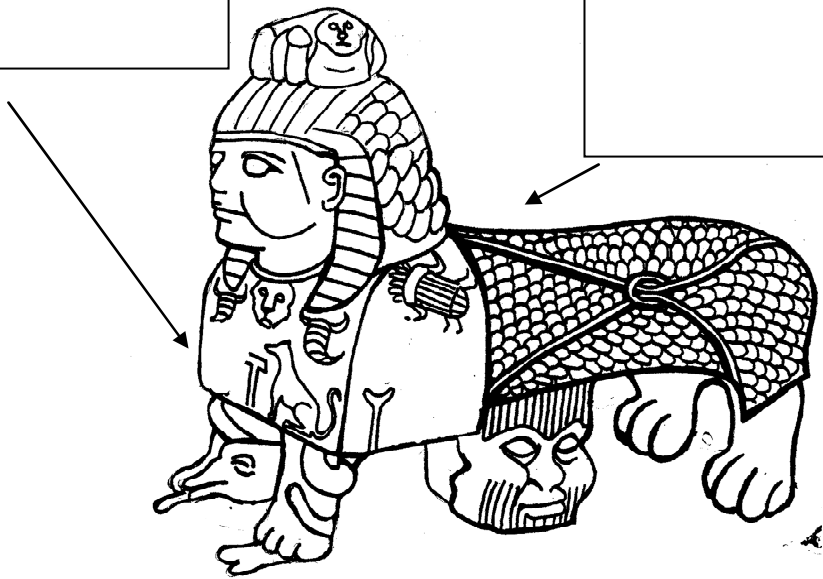
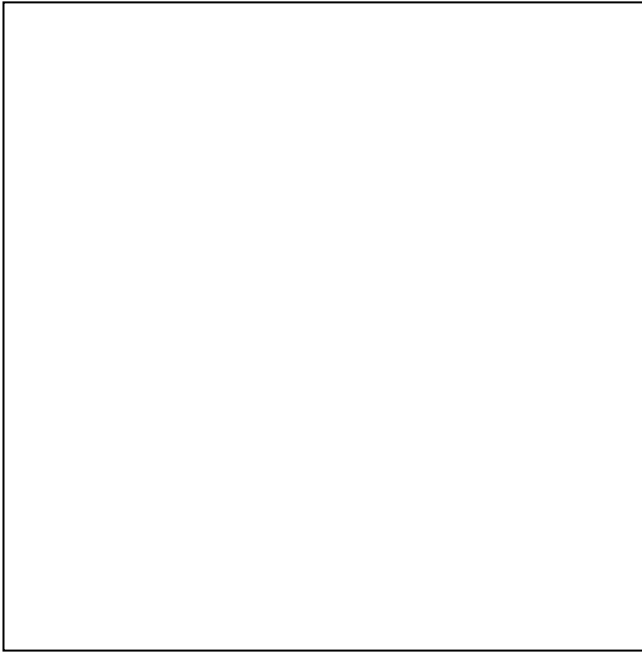
Find the big sphinx.

Two animals are missing in this drawing. Draw them in the boxes.

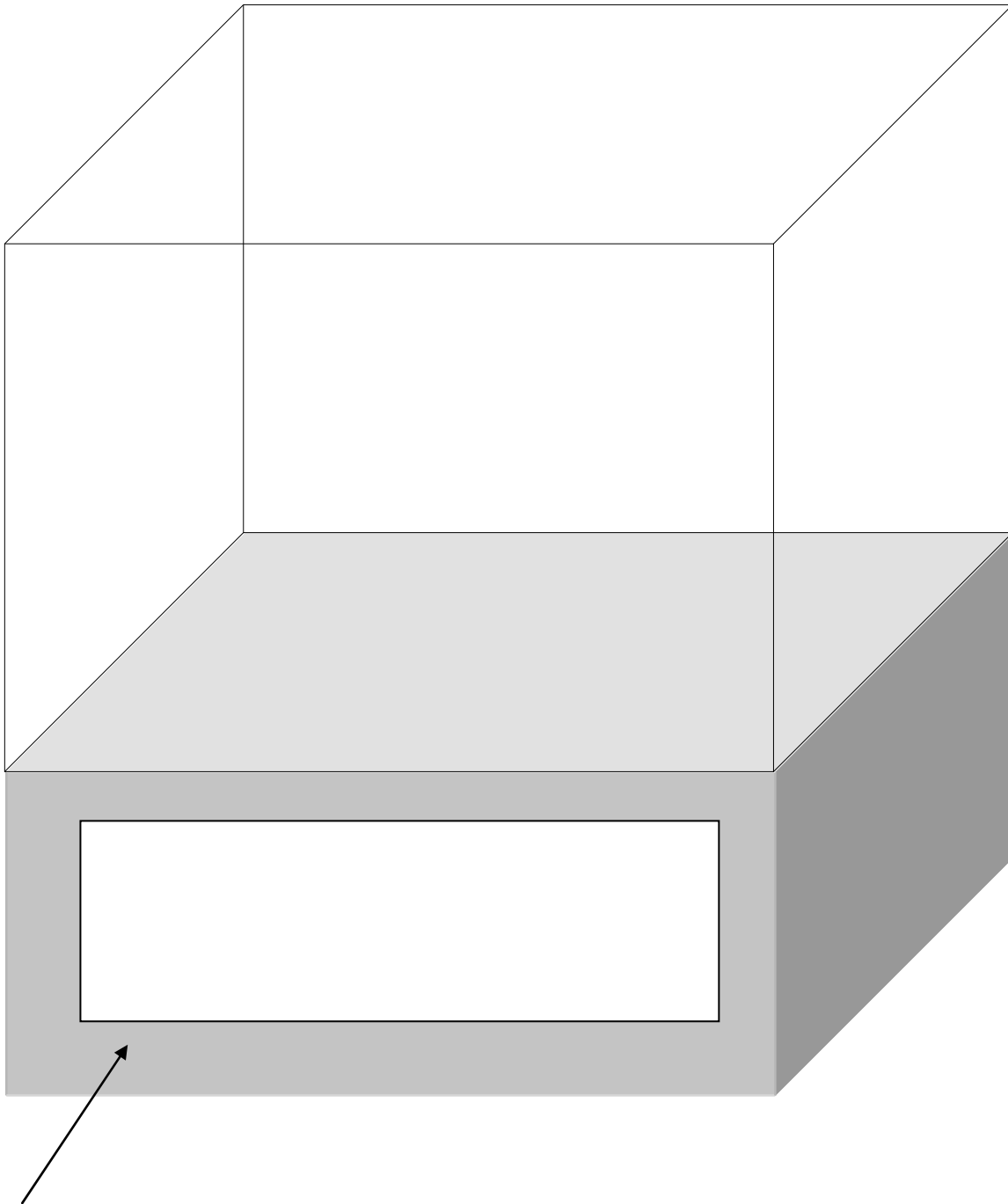


Your museum
