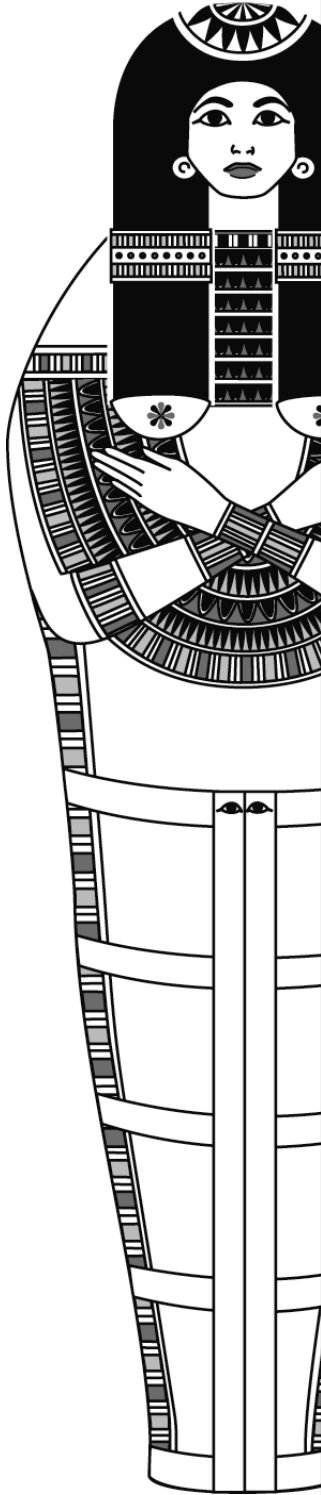

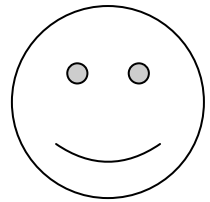

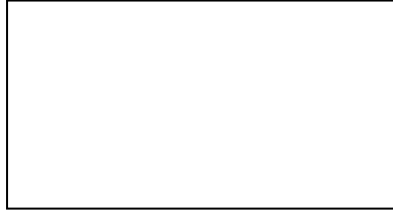
In Ancient Egypt, both men and women wore jewellery.

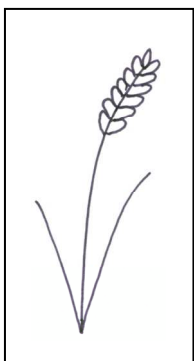

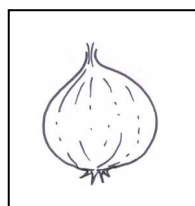

Farmers in Ancient Egypt grew wheat, barley, flax and vegetables such as beans and onions.

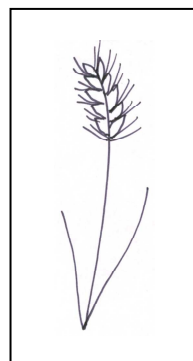

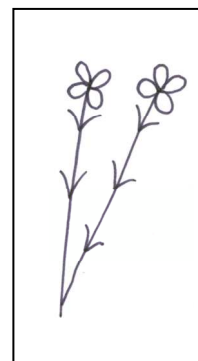

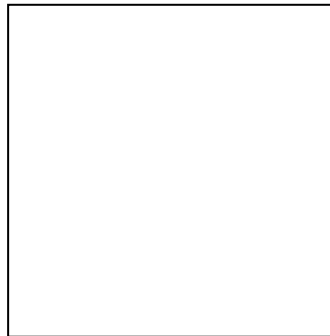
The Stone mason

In Ancient Egypt stone was used to carve statues and to build and decorate tombs, temples and houses.

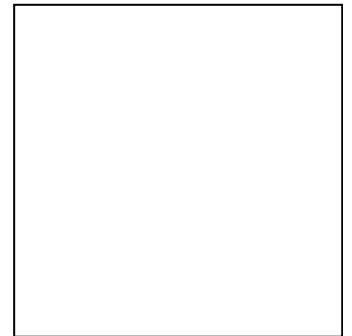
How many things in this case are made of stone ?-----

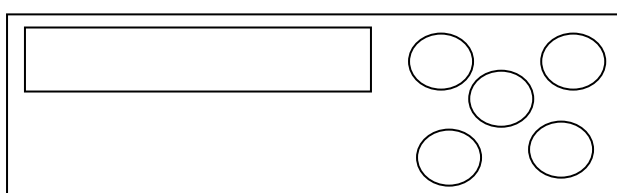
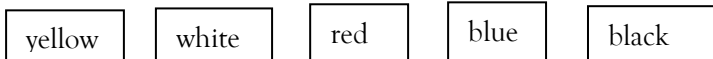

How many pens can you see in the palette? Draw them in.

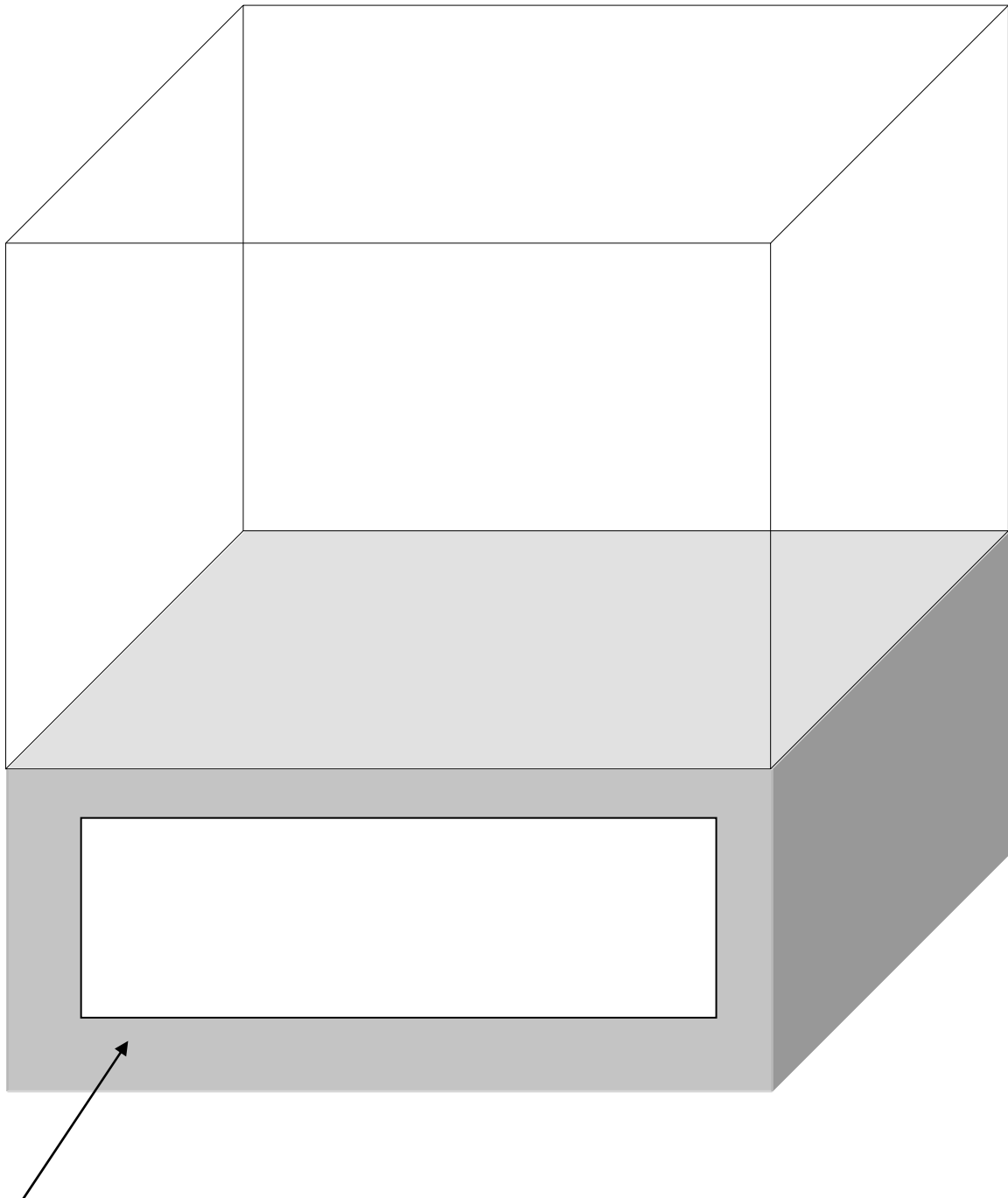
