Road, at present used by the Company for that purpose, to other premises fronting Mearns Quay and Ocean Row, Point Law.

The Council instructed the Town Clerk to give the requisite notice in terms of Section 32 (2) of the Public Health (Scotland) Act, 1897, that, at their meeting on 2nd August next, they will hear all persons objecting to such sanction being given.

17.—Communications were submitted from—

(1) The Aberdeen and District Bowling Association, intimating that the team of South African Bowlers, presently touring Great Britain, are to visit the City on the 24th proximo, and enquiring whether the Town Council desired to be associated with the reception of the team;

(2) The British Legion (Women's Section) suggesting, in connection with the Quarterly Conference of the British Legion (Women's Section) (Scotland), which is to be held in Aberdeen on the 28th August, that a civic reception should be given to the delegates on

the occasion.

The Council remitted the communications to the Finance Committee for consideration and report.
