*Notice to Electors or Persons entitled to Vote in the Election of a Member of Parliament for the City of Aberdeen.*

THE TOWN-CLERK HEREBY GIVES NOTICE, that, in terms of the Acts of Parliament, the City of Aberdeen has been divided into Districts for Polling at the Election of a Member to serve in Parliament, and that the Polling-places in each of these Districts have been fixed as follow :—

## FIRST DISTRICT,

**Comprehending East and St. Clement's Parishes.**

POLLING-PLACE—at or near Weigh-house Square.

## SECOND DISTRICT,

**Comprehending North and Greyfriars Parishes.**

POLLING-PLACE—at or near the North side of Castle Street.

## THIRD DISTRICT,

**Comprehending West and South Parishes.**

POLLING-PLACE—at or near the North Gate of Robert Gordon's Hospital.

*Note.*—The Parishes above mentioned are not those into which the City has lately been divided, *quoad sacra*, but the six Parishes of Aberdeen or St. Nicholas, as formerly established.

## FOURTH DISTRICT,

**Comprehending those parts of the Parish of Old Machar which are situated to the South of the Denburn, and that part of the Parish of Banchory-Devenick, near the Bridge of Dee, comprehended within the boundary of the Burgh, as fixed by the Act of Parliament.**

POLLING-PLACE—at or near the crossing of Rose Street and Thistle Street, Northward from Union Street.

## FIFTH DISTRICT,

**Comprehending those parts of the Parish of Old Machar which are situated between the Denburn on the south, and the River Don on the north.**

POLLING-PLACE—at or near the Town-house of Old Aberdeen.
