I know you look forward to such an event with emotions of pleasure. In the view of such, then, I repeat it, let loyalty and propriety of behaviour characterise you, for this, I assure you, is the best evidence of your being sincerely attached to Reform ; while, verily, it is the best *banner* that you can raise for the *man* who now presides over you, and who will not deem it any disparagement to his rank, talents, or character, to consult the welfare of the meanest citizen of you in another place, at another day.—Fellow Citizens,—
