

## THE GEORGE MILNE BEQUEST

1. The Scholarship is for a student undertaking a PhD in any area of Celtic at the University of Aberdeen.
2. The scholarship is for the sole purpose of undertaking a PhD in Celtic (as defined in the University of Aberdeen) in the University of Aberdeen, and cannot be used for any other degree, or in any other subject, or for any other purpose.
4. The scholarship will cover UK/EU postgraduate fees for a maximum of three years.

## SCHOLARSHIP CONDITIONS

1. Applicants must be able to demonstrate outstanding academic performance.
2. The scholarship recipient will be required to submit an annual report to the University of Aberdeen Development Trust detailing the progress of their studies at the end of each academic year.
3. The award holder must satisfy each year the criteria for progression as defined by the School of Language & Literature, and remain a student in good standing.

## APPLICATION PROCEDURE

If you have applied for and been offered a place on a postgraduate programme in the School of Language & Literature commencing in session 2010/11 you will be considered automatically for all relevant scholarships available in the School. The scholarships available through the School in session 2010/11 are:

The Professor Adolphus Jack Scholarship – English Literature

To be eligible for any of these awards, your application for postgraduate study must be approved by the School of Language & Literature by the cut-off date of **Friday 14<sup>th</sup> May 2010**.
