Beautiful Dachau is an experimental documentary using an observational cinematic narrativized style. It explores the spatial relationship and integration of the well-known SS concentration camp within the fabric of the picturesque Bavarian town, Dachau, and its larger neighbor Munich. The film presents a visual statement about how people engage with place set against a tragic inherited meaning and weight of history, transfiguring past events with their presence.
