1) Finance

ANDREW has taken charge of printing sponsor forms, gathering volunteers for the event, and organising transport to and from the stately home.

3) Sub-Committee Meeting

- At the last Sub-Committee Meeting, several fundraising events were proposed. These are : A Guitar Hero night at The Union on 13th Nov, a Quiz Night at The Tunnels (date to be confirmed), a sponsored legwaxing at MacRobert (date to be confirmed), a sponsored Cycle (proposed for Mon 17th Nov), dressing-up for any bag-packing events, and Caroling, to start in 2nd last weekend in November.

4) Other events

- There will be a Round Table AGM requiring a choir, and the Winter Gardens carol service will again be taking place. TOM is to enquire about these events.

5) Video Filming

- HELEN would like a video to be projected whilst the Overture of 'Ruddigore' plays, giving the back-story of the show, with all of the Ruddigore ghosts meeting their ends, etc. ANDREW has agreed to film and edit this video, and KATE is to be the production assistant, responsible for props etc. ANDREW has looked at potential locations at Fyvie Castle. HELEN has had 8 responses from potential costume assistants, and has upcoming meetings with them. Costumes are required for the filming, and also the photographing of the 'ghost portraits' at the same time. ANDREW has asked for the filming to occur

before Christmas, because of publicity / programme commitments he will have in the New Year. She also has a meeting planned with Court Jesters, in the hope of getting costumes from this company.
