FAQs

When/How do I apply for accommodation?

Once the online application form is open, any students holding an unconditional offer can apply. Students with a conditional offer will be able to note an interest and complete the application once they have received their certificate of acceptance.

Is accommodation guaranteed?

We guarantee all new full time, full year students an offer of a place in a single occupancy bedroom, either within our own portfolio of accommodation or with one of our preferred partners, provided the application reaches us by the deadline*.

What do I do once I have been allocated a room?

You will be required to accept a contract and pay the relevant amount to secure your room within a specified timescale

How much does it cost?

We offer a wide range of accommodation with varying costs to suit every budget. Current prices can be found at: abdn.ac.uk/accommodation

What are the choices for catered meals?

Catered packages offer a weekly meal plan allowance, so you can purchase meals, hot drinks and snacks at University owned food outlets at times that suit you**.

What happens during vacation?

Our accommodation remains open during vacation periods and the accommodation team remain onsite all year round to provide support.

What support is available?

All University campuses offer 24/7 security. The accommodation team also deal with a wide variety of issues including lockouts, noise complaints and maintenance. Student Resident Assistants (SRAs) are available at night and weekends to help with welfare issues and organise social events.

Can I get Wi-Fi in my room?

Yes, all University campuses and residences are covered by a free, unlimited Wi-Fi service.

Can part-time students apply

for accommodation?

Full time students are given priority, but it is often possible to accommodate part-time students as well.

How do I pay my rent?

Is there a deadline for accommodation applications?

We recommend booking your accommodation as early as possible as demand for certain rooms can be high. The guarantee of a room only applies if your application is received by the stated deadline.
