What advice would you give to students thinking about employment in your field?

Don't disregard any role offered to you. Sometimes these abstract roles are a way of reaching your target career. Research the company you apply for. It's remarkable how little people understand what scientific publishing actually entails; the job roles are not the same as other publishing companies.

Is there any other advice you would like to give to current students moving from university to working life?
