- 3. Roll of the graduates of the University of Aberdeen, 1926-1955, with supplement 1860–1925, ed. J. MacKintosh (Aberdeen, Aberdeen University Press, 1960)
- 4. Roll of the graduates of the University of Aberdeen, 1956–1970, with supplement 1860-1955, compilers Louise Donald & W. S. MacDonald (Aberdeen, Aberdeen University Press, 1982)

## WHAT INFORMATION IS RECORDED

The volumes list graduates only, but contain more information about the students than the earlier published lists for King's College and Marischal College, such as courses studied, parentage, marriage information and career.

The Rolls also update information on alumni in successive volumes in the Supplementary section so it is sometimes possible to find further details about the life and career of a particular graduate up to the year 1970. Supplementary information was provided by students or their families and not from University records or sources and therefore updates to a student's record will not apply in every case.

They also often provide a cross-reference to an obituary in the *Aberdeen University Review* (AUR) (available in the Wolfson Reading Room) and an entry in the published *Roll of Service* and *Book of Remembrance*, available to search here: <a href="https://www.abdn.ac.uk/library/roll-of-honour/">https://www.abdn.ac.uk/library/roll-of-honour/</a>. Lists of honorary graduates are also provided at the end of each volume.

# WHAT INFORMATION IS NOT RECORDED

The rolls from 1860-1970 do not record the names of people who registered to study at the University and did not complete the course and graduate. They also do not list the names of members of staff for this period. Please see the **Additional Resources** section at the end of this document for more information regards staff.
