Pawel Pawlikowski's acclaimed feature films, *My Summer of Love* (2004) and *Last Resort* (2000), won BAFTAs and awards at the Edinburgh Film Festival. Born in Warsaw, Pawlikowski directed a number of highly original BBC documentaries, including *Serbian Epics* (1992), which was made at the height of the Bosnian war, and includes scenes of Radovan Karadzic and General Ratko Mladic, who were later sought for war crimes.
