E-journals (more in Primo). Examples include: Accountancy; Accounting auditing & accountability journal; The British Accounting Review; International Journal of Management Science; Journal of Consumer Behaviour; Journal of Management Studies.

[ProQuest One Business](#) (link from Primo) – see our [Quick Guide to ProQuest One Business](#).

Formerly called Business Premium Collection, One Business is a platform combining the following ProQuest databases: ABI/INFORM; Accounting, Tax & Banking; Asian & European Business; Business Market Research; Business Video database; Entrepreneurship database; J.P. Morgan Research.

One Business contains academic journals, SSRN working papers, trade magazines, titles such as the Financial Times and The Economist, and PhD theses, many in full text. 1971 to current.

It also covers company, industry, economic and geopolitical market research with information from Hoover's Company Profiles, OxResearch, Barnes Reports and Snapshots. 1986 – current.

Contains more than 15,000 authoritative, current ebooks in full text on management-related subjects.

[JSTOR](#) (link from Primo).

Contains more than 200 journals on management-related subjects (not many current parts).

[Scopus](#) (link from Primo).

This is a multi-disciplinary database, so focus your search using the Subject Area headings in the left-hand column on the results page. Click on the **Find It** button to search for full text online or Primo for a print version where available.

[SpringerLink](#) (link from Primo).

Contains more than 8,000 full text, authoritative ebooks on accountancy and management.

[Web of Science](#) (link from Primo).

This is a multi-disciplinary database. Click on 'more settings' on the Search screen and deselect all of the irrelevant databases. Focus your search further using the Web of Science Categories in the left-hand column on the results page. Click on the **Find It** button to search for full text online or Primo for a print version where available.
