The MLAIB covers both language and literature. The Criticism and Reference section of LION has access to the MLAIB. Some links to full text are included. When a list of results is generated click on the **Find It** button to link to full text where available.

Web of Science - Arts & Humanities Citation Index

A database within Web of Science, the Arts & Humanities Citation Index lists millions of journal articles. The **Find It** button searches for full text online or checks the catalogue for a print version where available.

JSTOR

More than 300 of the top language and literature journals from start to recent issues. Also a section on Latin American Studies. Mostly full text, but if not, click on the title of the article to find the **Find It** button.
