

Licence conditions

Four different flavours of licence conditions.



BY - attribution

You must include an acknowledgement to the original creator.



NC - non-commercial

You can reuse the material for non-commercial purposes only.



SA - share alike

If you create a new work using it, you must license it under the same licence as the original.



ND - no derivatives

You can redistribute the original, but you can't make any adaptations to it.

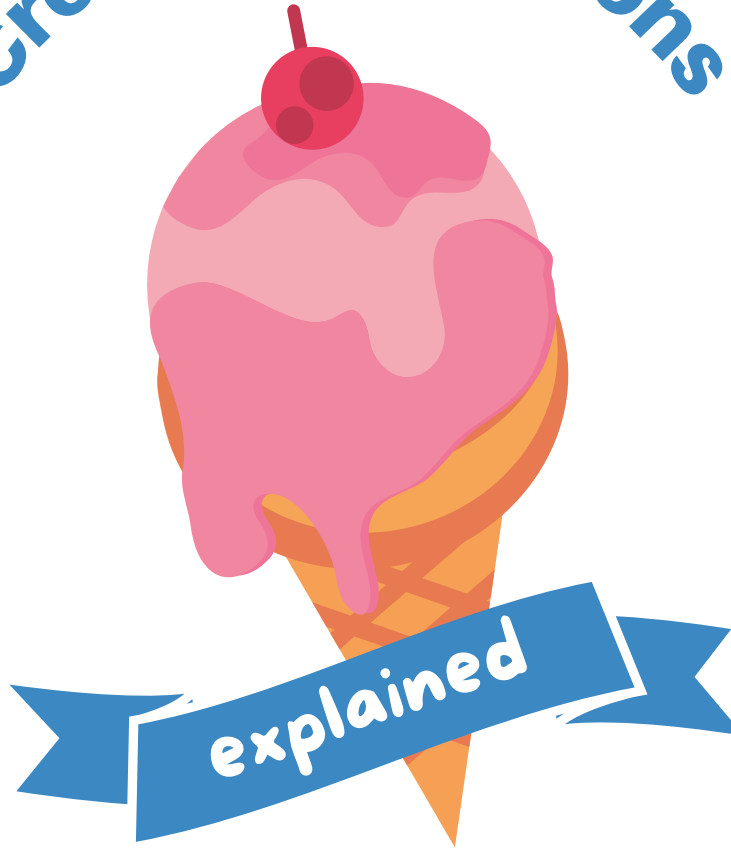
Public domain - CC0

With a CC0 licence there are no restrictions. You can use the material for any purpose, and you don't even need to credit the original creator.

Sharing under a Creative Commons licence is easy! Just make sure you or your publisher includes a statement with the relevant licence name on your work, like this one.

Licence types

Mix and match conditions to make your licence.



CC BY

Use the material for any purpose. You must credit the creator.

CC BY-NC

Use the material for any non-commercial purpose. You must credit the creator.

CC BY-SA

Use the material for any purpose. You must credit the creator. You must share adaptations under CC BY-SA.

CC BY-ND

Redistribute the material for any purpose. You must credit the creator. You must not make any changes to the material.

CC BY-NC-SA

Use the material for any non-commercial purpose. You must credit the creator. You must share adaptations under CC BY-NC-SA.

CC BY-NC-ND

Redistribute the material for non-commercial purposes. You must credit the creator. You must not make any changes to the material.
