

Vaccine	Protects Against	Recommended Dosage	Eligibility
MMR	Measles, Mumps and Rubella.	2 doses (Minimum 4 weeks apart)	No upper age limit. No previously recorded MMR or incomplete MMR vaccination history.
MenACWY	Infections caused by meningococcal bacteria groups A, C, W and Y.	1 dose	Individuals with no history of MenACWY vaccination remain eligible until their 25th birthday.
HPV	<p>Most common types of Human Papillomavirus that cause:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cervical cancer</li> <li>• Cancers linked to HPV, including vulval, vaginal, anal, penile, and some throat (oropharyngeal) cancers</li> <li>• Genital warts</li> </ul>	1 dose	<p>Females are eligible for HPV vaccination up until their 25th birthday.</p> <p>Because the HPV vaccination programme for boys began later in the UK, men are eligible only if they were born on or after <i>1 September 2006</i>.</p> <p>Older men are not routinely eligible unless they fall into one of the categories below.</p> <p>If you think you may be eligible under one of below these groups, please contact local sexual health services on 0345 3379900</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• MSM (Men who have sex with men) aged up to 45 years</li> <li>• Transgender individuals attending sexual health or HIV clinic who are felt to have the same risk as MSM.</li> <li>• Sex Workers</li> <li>• Men &amp; Women living with HIV infection.</li> </ul>
