Excursions – discover Germany & Europe!

To provide students the opportunity to fully experience their time in Germany, we have organized several courses with faculty-led excursions. In Fall the courses offered are “European Welfare States and Health Systems”, including trips to Berlin (Charité) and the “Bauhaus” which includes trips to Weimar and Dessau. In spring, students can take “Art in Germany “ with almost weekly excursions to museums in Bremen, Hannover and Hamburg.

To further set students up for success and navigate the exceedingly high level of diversity at Constructor University, all exchange students attend a tailor-made Intercultural Competence and Culturally Sensitive Communications Course that includes a trip to the German Emigration Center in Bremerhaven.

Application package

1. General Information

(for free movers from non-partner universities only)

2. University Transcripts

Applicants must upload a copy of an official transcript from the university they are currently attending. Constructor requires students to hold a GPA of at least 3.0 in American numerical value (letter grade B or equivalent).

3. Proof of English proficiency

All non-native English speakers are required to prove the CEFR B2 level of English proficiency (IELTS score 5.5 – 6.5; TOEFL iBT score 80; TOEIC score 650 – 800; Cambridge FCE). The only exception is if students are native speakers, or come from a university where English is the language of instruction and examination.



Health insurance



EU citizens must present proof of their health insurance when coming to Constructor University and verify that their health insurance meets the German standard. It is strongly recommended for non-EU members to acquire German Public health insurance.



Visa



All study abroad students who need a visa to enter Germany should apply for a student visa. A visitor's visa or any other type of visa cannot be changed into a student visa upon arrival to Germany. Visa support is available at visa@constructor.university. It takes six to eight weeks for visa applications to be approved.
