Dates of semesters Start/end	<p>1st semester : beginning of September to mid-January (<i>exams are held in December, the week before the end-of-year holidays, and in January, the 1st week after the holidays</i>)</p> <p>2nd semester : mid-January to the beginning of May (<i>exams are held in April, until the beginning of May</i>)</p> <p>Exams resit session : in June</p> <p>The academic calendar is published on our website every year in July. Learning agreement	Students register for the courses before their arrival but they can modify their choices until the beginning of October for the 1 st semester and beginning of February for the 2 nd semester.
Language requirements	<p>As most of the lectures are held in French, it is necessary that the students have good knowledge of French (B2 level recommended). However no certificate is required.</p> <p>We have increased our offer in English taught classes, therefore exchange students can choose only English taught classes (B2 level recommended).</p> <p>Any combination is possible: all courses in French, all courses in English or a combination of both.</p>
Transcript of records	The transcript of records will be sent to the Home University (via email in priority and regular mail if necessary) and to the student (via email only).
Length of the exchange period	One year or one semester
Services available for exchange students	<p>Information packages</p> <p>The International Office sends all incoming exchange students information packages by email. It includes general information about the Faculty of Law, the admission procedure, as well as information about accommodation.</p> <p>We recommend your outgoing students to register the following email: droit-erasmus@unistra.fr in their contact list. 	<p>Outgoing students from the Faculty of Law of the University of Strasbourg will be nominated before the end of March or in April according to our partner's application deadline.</p>
Accommodation information	<p>It may be possible for exchange students to get a room at the university campus <u>but they have to apply within the deadline</u> and arrive on the date they have indicated. However, note that the university does not guarantee housing on campus.</p> <p>Attention : please note that the rooms are allocated, as a priority, to exchange students nominated for the full year.</p> <p>It is more difficult for students coming for one semester only to get accommodation on campus.</p> <p>Cost of accommodation in the student residences: Between 190 and 350 €/month. It depends on the room (with or without private bathroom and toilets). About 450 to 500 €/month for a studio apartment.</p> <p>Private accommodations: The following link might be useful for those students deciding not to live in a student residence but preferring to look for a private accommodation : https://www.unistra.fr/vie-des-campus/logement</p>
Health Insurance	<p>All European students have to present a valid health insurance when enrolling. They must bring their European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) with them.</p> <p>Non-EU students must register with the French student Social Security system : https://etudiant-etranger.ameli.fr/#/</p> <p>Students from Quebec are exempt from joining the French student Social Security upon presentation of form # SE 401-Q-106.</p>
