Credit Transfer	Generally, in Wuhan University one credit consists of 18class hours, assignments and a final exam. Any academic credit received in Wuhan University may be transferred to your home university in accordance with the regulations of your home University		
Transcripts	Students can request your official final transcript in the Teaching Affairs. Office of SIE once you finish all exams. Results are usually ready in about a week after the exam. In the event that results are not available before your departure, you can authorize a third-party to collect your transcrip (recommended) or choose to mail the transcript to a home address (postage payment involved).		

Application Information and Deadlines



#### **Procedure**

- 1. Home University Coordinator provides students with nomination forms.
- 2. Students fill in the nomination form after confirming that there are optional courses according to their language level and corresponding major.
- 3. Home University Coordinator sends the nomination form containing all nominated students to Wuhan University by email.
- 4. Wuhan University conducts a unified review of the nomination forms after the deadline.
- 5. Wuhan University notifies successful applicants and issues further instructions.
- 6. Exchange students complete their online application.

#### Please note:

The nomination should be done before the following deadline.

Deadline: Fall/Winter term: May 10th

Spring/Summer term: October 15th

Application dates are as follows:

The 2026 Spring Semester: October 15 to December 31, 2025

The 2026 Autumn Semester: April 15 to June 15, 2026 (provisional)

# Considerations for Nomination & Application

The home institution's exchange coordinator should send the entire nominated student's information to <a href="mailto:inbound@whu.edu.cn">inbound@whu.edu.cn</a> before the deadline. In view of cultural exchange and mutual learning, applicants should, in principle, be foreign students without Chinese nationality.

Students complete online application and upload application documents before the deadline at http://fses-admin.whu.edu.cn/member/login.do or http://fses-admin.whu.edu.cn/

It should be noted that **Chinese nationality** students **cannot** apply for this system, and students who have registered before do not need to register again.

# Visa Requirements

After receiving the Admission Letter from WHU, the applicant should submit the visa application package to the Chinese Embassy/Consulate General to apply for X visa.

Within 180 days: X2visa (would NOT be converted into other visas after registering in WHU)

Over 180 days: X1visa (would be converted into a residence permit after registering in WHU)

## **Please note:**

If entering China with other types of Visas, you will be not allowed to register in Wuhan University. It's impossible to get X visa in China, you need apply X visa before you come.

For your convenience, we recommend that you take the taxi to arrive at school in the Luojia Gate (珞珈门). After your admission letter (录取通知书) showed to the security personnel, the taxi can enter the campus.</li> <li>You will be required to register and pay the application and accommodation fees in the School of International Education Wuhan University (武汉大学国际教育学院).</li> <li>The Chinese above can be provided to the taxi driver in order that you get to the right place.</li> <li>The issues after exchange students' arrival should be in the charge of the School of International Education.</li> <li>Please note: Students must enroll on time. If you cannot arrive on time due to any special reason, please apply for deferred registration (within 7 days) with the signature of your home institution's coordinator at the admissions office in the School of International Education. ## Insurance

#### Health insurance

Please note: All the students are required to pay for the local health insurance according to the regulation of our country. 400 RMB per semester, 800RMB per year.

Two days before your entry, please purchase insurance according to the instructions in the "Online Payment Process of Insurance for International Students in China". If you need to seek medical treatment due to covid-19or other diseases during the quarantine period (when you arrive in China but not on campus), you are supposed to contact the insurance company to pay for the treatment expenses in accordance with the regulations of the medical insurance for international students studying in China.
