# Leverhulme Trust Outline Project Grant Applications: February 2026 deadline, ahead of system change

The Leverhulme Research Project Grants scheme normally does not have a set outline application deadline. However, the Trust will move to a new Grants Management System as the current system will no longer be supported after December 2026. Applications in progress cannot be transferred to the new system.

Therefore, **outline applications must be submitted by 27 February 2026**. There will then be a pause until September 2026, when new outline applications will be accepted in the new system.

For applicants who have been or will be invited to submit a Detailed Application, the deadlines will be closer and you will have less time to develop and submit your detailed application.
