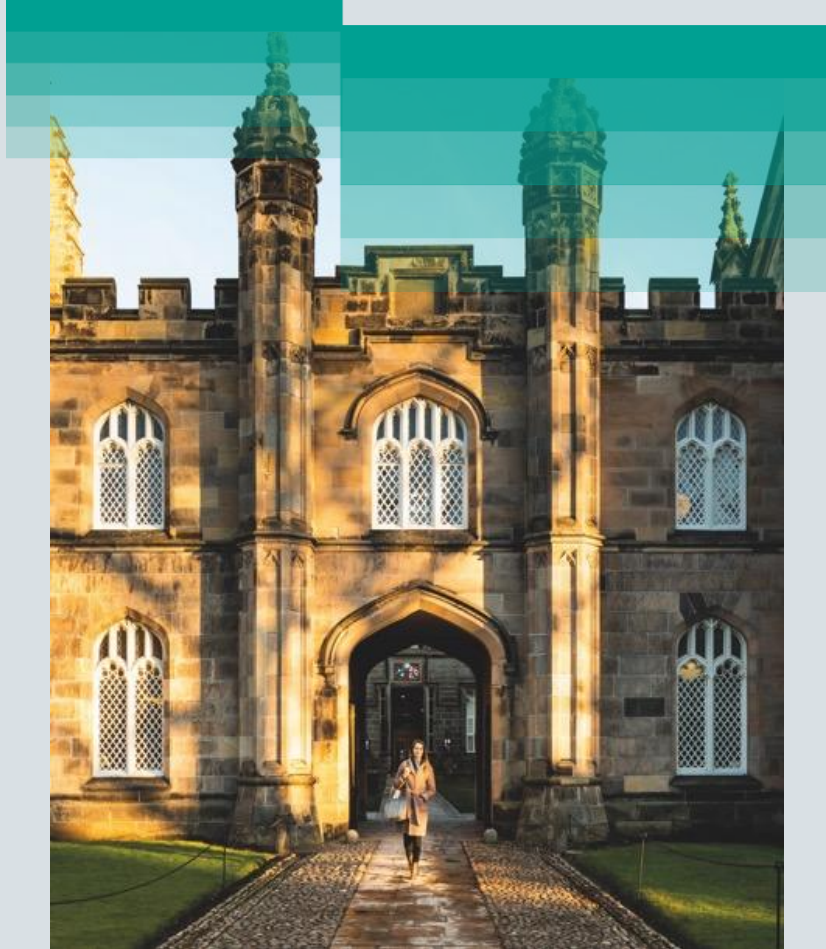

Placement

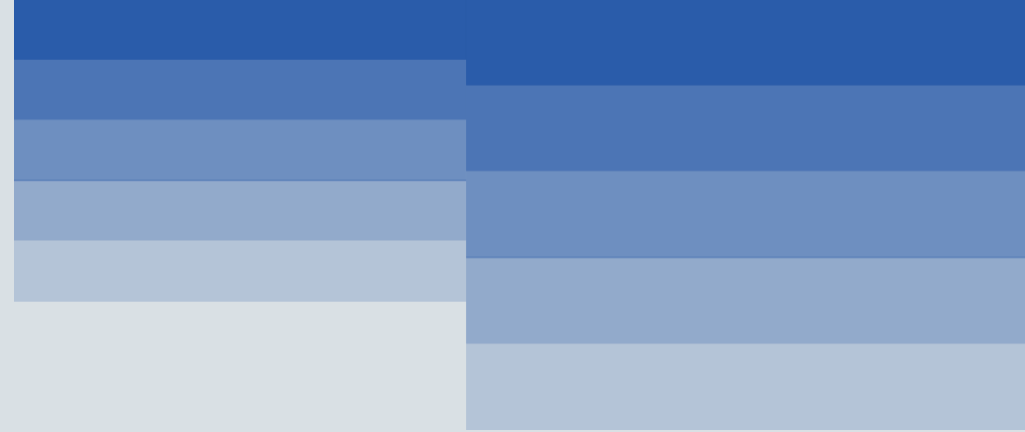
Aberdeen City, Aberdeenshire, Moray, Highland, Western Isles, Shetland
