History

AFG College with the University of Aberdeen is a unique partnership between the Al Faleh Group for Educational and Academic Services (AFG) and the University of Aberdeen which opened its doors to students in September 2017. We currently offer undergraduate programmes in Accounting & Finance, Business Management, Business Management & Information Systems, Business Management & International Relations, Business Management & Legal Studies, Computing Science and Politics & International Relations in addition to seven postgraduate degrees in Master of Business Administration (MBA), MSc International Business Management, LLM International Commercial Law, MSc International Human Resource Management, MSc Global Business Communication, MSc Global Energy Transition Systems & Technologies and Master of Public Health (MPH). We never stop growing and developing as a university and have ambitious plans to expand the portfolio of programmes we offer in Qatar.

Plans are underway to build a new campus in Al Daayan, near Doha, which represents an anticipated £ 100m investment by AFG and marks the second phase of its partnership with the University. At around 35,000 square metres, the campus provides ample space to expand the range of programmes offered by the University of Aberdeen to include STEM (science, technology, engineering and mathematics subjects) medical sciences, law, politics and international relations.

DESCRIPTION OF PROGRAMME

The most popular professional degree programme in the world, the MBA is a globally-recognised qualification designed to develop your leadership skills, underpinned by practical and theoretical knowledge. It offers you the opportunity to formally recognise your business expertise and take you to a higher level in terms of career progression, earnings potential and job satisfaction. Although the programme is aimed at working professionals, with significant business experience, there is still a lot to learn. The MSc International Business Management programme enables you to build commercial awareness and gain a deep understanding of the challenges and trends facing global business leaders today. The world's economy is increasingly global, and demand continues to grow for the leaders of the future who clearly understand the international context of business.

This programme helps recent graduates and early-stage professionals from any background to develop a global career in business and management. By specialising in international business you will become more marketable to employers.

DESCRIPTION OF PROGRAMME

The MSc International Human Resource Management aims to develop knowledgeable practitioners with an appreciation of multi-cultural international practice. The course will help you to be able to critically measure HR interventions using quantitative/ qualitative, scientific and psychological approaches to managing human resources. This MSc will also equip you with the tools to critically examine and apply contemporary approaches to HR management within organisations that are operating in a global environment. It will cover the financial, project management and relationship skills you need to succeed in global HR management.

The MSc covers core areas in HR such as Resourcing and Talent Management, Managing Performance and Digital Engagement and Relationships. You'll develop a thorough understanding of fundamental concepts, principles, theories, practices and legislative frameworks underlying international human resource management.

You will be able to critically examine and translate your learning of organisations within a changing global environment using quantitative and qualitative skills. DESCRIPTION OF PROGRAMME

This degree will provide you with a deep understanding of the legal functions required to operate within the rapidly changing international business environment. You will gain insight into specific areas of international commercial law, which will include the regulation of financial and commercial activities within an organization, as well as international perspectives in company law.

The LLM International Commercial Law will equip you with the necessary skills and knowledge to make you proficient in the complex modern-day international commercial law arena. Throughout this degree you will engage with diverse issues arising across the business and legal spectrum and will develop an enhanced understanding of a specialist area of law.

This programme is suited to recent law graduates, practicing lawyers, Government officials, in-house counsel, and legal and compliance officers.

Our staff are highly qualified and motivated academics with significant experience and knowledge of their respective fields of law.

The programme will be taught on an intensive, block-teaching basis. Students will be given tasks and readings to complete in advance of a faculty visit, which will comprise of five days of intensive instruction.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

A first degree in law with a degree classification of 2.1 or above in Law or a related discipline will normally be required for entry to the programme. In exceptional circumstances, applicants not having a law degree but possessing significant relevant experience may be admitted to the programme.

Master of Public Health (MPH)

DESCRIPTION OF PROGRAMME

Our Master of Public Health (MPH) programme combines the traditional pillars of public health (e.g. Health Protection and Health Improvement) along with emerging topics such as Health Informatics and Women's Health together with fundamental research skills and is suited to healthcare professionals looking to combine clinical and academic skills and those from other disciplines interested in pursuing careers in academic public health, NGOs, teaching or industry.

You will be taught by experienced lecturers who include both renowned academics and expert practitioners to give you the holistic understanding of public health. Your learning is enriched by interaction with other students from varied clinical, non-clinical, professional, and cultural backgrounds. Undertaking this MPH does not require any specialist knowledge (e.g., clinical).

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

A health-related degree at 2:2 (Lower-second class) UK Honours level, or a degree from a non-UK institution which is judged by the University to be of equivalent worth, or be able to demonstrate evidence of equivalent experience in health care practice or research.

Students from non-health backgrounds: a degree at 2:2 (Lower-second class) UK Honours level in science, social science, or humanities subjects will be considered for the programme.

In recent years, the transition towards sustainable energy systems has gathered huge momentum. Yet, despite the substantial progress around the world, the energy transition continues to pose significant technological, commercial, and political challenges for businesses and governments.

This programme provides an extensive overview of the diverse technical and non-technical (e.g. economic, policy) challenges associated with the transition to cleaner and more sustainable energy.

You will learn about the latest technological innovations in areas such as wind, tidal and hydrogen, energy storage, carbon storage and biofuels and engage with the wider economic and political aspects of the energy transition.

- 2:1 (upper second class) UK Honours degree, or an Honours degree from a non-UK institution which is judged by the University to be of equivalent worth, in Engineering or a related field such as the natural sciences, physical sciences or mathematics.
- Or 2:2 (lower second class) UK Honours degree in Engineering or a related field, or equivalent with 5+ years relevant experience

DESCRIPTION OF PROGRAMME

Our MSc in Global Business Communication provides in-depth communications skills and knowledge across business, law, health care, politics, media and energy industries. You will learn to communicate effectively and pragmatically in situations reliant on an understanding of human behaviour, relationships, tactics, and politics to uncover powerful solutions to challenges in communication and interpretation.

This programme is a dynamic and engaging programme as it combines a multidisciplinary approach to allow you to acquire skills and knowledge in organisational negotiation, leadership and rapport management. You examine interaction in a range of professional institutions and business organisations. The programme is designed to equip you with higher level skills in interpreting and analysing communication and interaction in professional situations to allow you to progress a career in Communications.

You will study intercultural communication, organisational behaviour and institutional communication. These are covered in the courses which make up this programme. The MSc in Global Business Communication is led by an expert team of lecturers.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Degree at 2:1 (Upper-second class) UK Honours level (or a degree from a non-UK institution which is judged by the University to be of equivalent worth).

A range of undergraduate degree backgrounds including language, linguistics, communication, business studies, law or legal studies

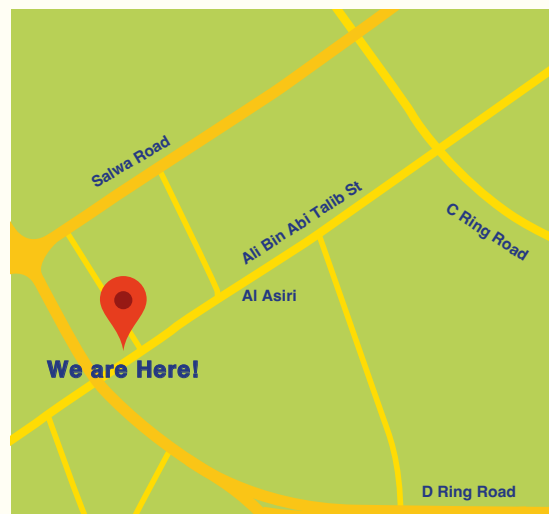
