their friendly assistance towards the general massacres, fire raisings, and *heart-burnings*, which will abound at that period.

Wanted, a few blood-hounds, and about 200 men and poissardes, who will find caution to sing "Ca Ira," and "the Marseilloise Hymn," in the true Parisian style. Also, wanted about 500 able-bodied grave-diggers, and a few coal-lighters to assist in the Noyades.

Insurance.—As we have the best authority for supposing that the anarchy and confusion will commence immediately after the bill comes into operation, those wishing to be insured against having their throats cut, may apply as above; and those who are anxious to serve as substitutes will meet with every encouragement.
