1.	Language competency levels are listed as a guide, courses may vary based on ability and are subject to diagnostic testing.
2.	Candidates seeking entry to the Junior Honours programme must have accumulated, by award or recognition, or been exempted from, at least 240 credit points at levels 1 and 2, including the prescribed courses required to enter programme year 3.
3.	Acceptable Geography courses for Programme Years 3 and 4 are: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• any Level 3 or 4 GG-coded course</li> <li>• any Level 3 or 4 MR-coded course</li> </ul>
4.	Students are advised to take at least one of GG 3570 or GG 3575 in Programme Year 3
5.	Students wanting to do one of the Honours field courses (GG 33577 or GG 3578) must register for these in Programme Year. This may entail registering for an extra 15 credits. Note that the trips run in the summer vacation.
6.	<b><u>Dissertation in Hispanic Studies:</u></b> This is a year-long course, with timetabled classes in the first half-session.
