| 3. | Students are required to undertake either FI 3503 International Finance Management or FI 3505 Advanced Corporate Finance. These courses run in alternate years, with FI 3503 running in Academic Year 2023/24. |
| 4. | <u>Dissertation in Spanish:</u> This is a year-long course, with timetabled classes in the first half-session. |
