1.	Language competency levels are listed as a guide, courses may vary based on ability and are subject to diagnostic testing.
2.	GH 3022 and GH 4022 run across both half sessions.
3.	Candidates for Joint Honours in Gaelic with another subject must attend the Gaelic Language Summer school, if available, or satisfy the Programme Co-ordinator that they have accrued equivalent language experience: eg by taking a summer Gaelic work placement.
4.	Candidates seeking entry to the Junior Honours programme must have accumulated, by award or recognition, or been exempted from, at least 240 credit points at levels 1 and 2, including the prescribed courses required to enter programme year 3.
5.	<u>Dissertation in Hispanic Studies:</u> This is a year-long course, with timetabled classes in the first half-session.
