1.	The overall CGS Grade in these courses will be awarded on the basis of the December paper (20%) and the May paper (80%).	
2.	These assessments cover the essential clinical skills and practices required to treat patients. All skills tests must be passed before carrying out these treatments on patients and all must be passed in order to progress to the subsequent year of study. These courses do not carry a CGS Grade but are recorded as "Achieved" or "Not Achieved". Resit period for courses is August. Students must achieve a pass in all of the above assessments in order to progress to the next year of the BDS programme.	
3.	Any student who does not achieve a pass in the December Clinical Scenario Paper will be given an opportunity to re-sit this paper at the end of Semester 2a. Any students who do not achieve a pass at this stage will be referred to the Clinical Progress Committee and will NOT be allowed to sit the end of Semester 2b degree assessments this academic year. The Clinical Skills and Practice Assessments must also be achieved prior to the April meeting of the Clinical Progress Committee. Students must achieve a pass in all of the above assessments in order to be awarded the degree of BDS. There is no re-sit opportunity in the current academic year, other than for DE5008. Students must undertake a period of further training before sitting the degree assessments for one final attempt in either December or the following June.
