PART TIME ROUTE

This route will run over two years. Students can take up to 120 credit points in a single year. PI5901 must be taken in Year 2. The following courses are compulsory and can be taken in either Year 1 or Year 2:

- PI5001 Strategic Theory (30 credit points)
- PI5025 Energy Politics (15 credit points)
- BU5053 Introduction to Energy Economics (15 credit points)

PI5502 Global Security Issues (30 credit points)

PI5518 International Energy Security (30 credit points)

Assessment: By written examination, essay work, class presentation, and project work as prescribed for each course, and by submission of a dissertation. The degree of MSc shall not be awarded to a candidate who fails to achieve a CGS mark of D3 or above in PI5901, irrespective of their performance in other courses.
