Assessment:

The dissertation can take two forms. For student who plan to complete their studies with the MSc, the MSc dissertation will report on a completed piece of independent and original research. Students who plan to proceed to PhD or EdD study may use their MSc dissertation to develop their research topic, clarify their research question, review the appropriate literature, explain and defend their research approach, and analyse and describe their preliminary findings as preparation for doctoral study.
