MINISTRY STUDIES (STUDENTS RESIDENT AT ZOMBA THEOLOGICAL COLLEGE) (MTh/PgDip/Pgcert) 58V6MAE2/61V6MAVX/62V6MAVZ

This programme is studied by students at Zomba Theological College by distance learning.

Duration: 24 months part-time.

Content:

During the 2018/19 academic year, all students, continuing or new, will take the following courses:

DR504J Preaching: Exploring the Theology & Practice of Christian Witness (30 credit points) DR554K Christian Practices (30 credit points)

Thereafter students will take the following courses in future academic years:

DR504L/ DR554L Patterns and Principles of Church Leadership (30 credit points)

DR504M/DR554M Spiritual Formation (30 credit points)

All students will take the following course in their second year of study:

DR554N Dissertation (60 credit points)

Only candidates who complete the programme of courses at an appropriate standard (attain a CGS grade of at least D3) will be allowed to progress to the dissertation. The topic of the dissertation will be agreed in advance with the supervisor.

Assessment: The taught courses will be assessed by a variety of means that may include book reviews, seminar presentations and written assignments. The dissertation course will be assessed by submission of the dissertation. The degree of MTh shall not be awarded to candidates who fail to achieve a CGS grade of D3 or above in the dissertation, irrespective of their performance in other courses; such candidates may, at the discretion of the Examiners, be awarded a Postgraduate Diploma if they have achieved the appropriate number of credits for that award.
