**Notes**

1.	Candidates for the Honours degree must achieve by award or recognition 480 credit points. Candidates granted exemption from one session under Regulation 2 may count 60 credits of recognition for study completed prior to entry towards this total of 480. Candidates granted such recognition must obtain not fewer than 180 credit points at level 3 or above; candidates not granted such recognition must obtain at least 240 credit points at level 3 or above. The total of credits required at level 3 or above must in all cases include at least 90 credit points at level 4, and may not include more than 30 credit points from courses out-with Divinity and Religious Studies.
2.	Candidates seeking entry to the Junior Honours programme must have accumulated, by award or recognition, or been exempted from, at least 240 credit points at levels 1 and 2, including the prescribed courses required to enter programme year 3.
3.	A graduating curriculum must include a minimum of 90 credits at level 4.
