*Duration:* 12 months full-time or 24 months part-time (MLitt); 12 months full-time or 24 months part-time (PgDip).

*Content:* Candidates undertake the following, (30 credits of Creative Writing EL coded level 5 courses may also be selected with permission of the relevant course coordinator):-

### **FULL TIME ROUTE**

#### Stage 1

Students must take the following:

EL5092 Approaching Literature 1 (30 credit points)

Plus 30 credits from available EL coded Level 5 courses:

EL50C2 Irish and Scottish Romanticism (30 credit points)

EL5089 Novel Ideas (30 credit points)

#### Stage 2

Students must take the following:

EL5598 Approaching Literature 2 (30 credit points)

Plus 30 credits from available EL coded Level 5 courses:

EL5590 Locations and Dislocations (30 credit points)

EL55C2 Writing the Self (30 credit points)

#### Stage 3

EL5904 Dissertation in English Literary Studies (MLitt) (60 credit points)

### **PART TIME ROUTE**

Students will take a total of 180 credits over two years.

#### Year 1

Students must take the following:

EL5092 Approaching Literature 1 (30 credit points)

Plus 30 credits from available EL coded Level 5 Courses:

EL55C2 Writing the Self (30 credit points)

EL5590 Locations and Dislocations (30 credit points)

## Year 2

30 credits from available EL coded Level 5 courses:

EL5089 Novel Ideas (30 credit points)

EL50C2 Irish and Scottish Romanticism (30 credit points)

Plus EL5598 Approaching Literature 2 (30 credit points)

EL5904 Dissertation in English Literary Studies (MLitt) (60 credit points)

*Assessment:* By a combination of coursework, written and oral examinations where appropriate for each course. The degree of MLitt shall not be awarded to a candidate who fails to achieve a CGS Grade of D3 or above in EL 5904, irrespective of their performance in other courses.
