

## TESOL (MSc/PgDip/PgCert)

*Duration:* 12 months full-time or 24 months part-time (MSc); 9 months full-time or 21 months part-time (PgDip).

*Content:* Candidates undertake the following:-

### **FULL TIME ROUTE**

#### Stage 1 (HS1)

- LN5010 English Structure and Use (PG) (0 credit points)
- LN5023 Theories of Learning (15 credit points)
- LN5027 Qualitative TESOL Research (15 credit points)
- LN5033 Quantitative TESOL Research (15 credit points)
- LN5036 Second Language Acquisition (15 credit points)

Stage 2 (HS2) – LN5516 and LN5511 will be taken jointly by the January and September start

- LN5511 TESOL Methodology: Teaching English as a Second or Other Language (30 credit points)

*PLUS*

Two of the following:

- LN5516 Peer Teaching in TESOL (15 credit points)
- LN5531 Creativity and Innovation in Language Teaching and Learning (15 credit points)
- LN5532 Curriculum and Materials Development (15 credit points)

#### Stage 3 (Summer)

- LN5906 TESOL Focussed Teaching Portfolio (MSc) (60 credit points)
- Or
- LN5908 Dissertation for MSc in TESOL (60 credit points)

### **PART TIME ROUTE**

This route will run over two years. Students can take up to 120 credit points in a single year. Students must take either LN5906 or LN5908 in Year 2. The following courses are compulsory and can be taken in either Year 1 or Year 2:

- LN5010 English Structure and Use (0 credit points)
- LN5023 Theories of Learning (15 credit points)
- LN5027 Qualitative TESOL Research (15 credit points)
- LN5033 Quantitative TESOL Research (15 credit points)
- LN5036 Second Language Acquisition (15 credit points)
- LN5511 TESOL Methodology: Teaching English as a Second or Other Language (30 credit points)

*PLUS*

Two of the following:

- LN5516 Peer Teaching in TESOL (15 credit points)
- LN5531 Creativity and Innovation in Language Teaching and Learning (15 credit points)
- LN5532 Curriculum and Materials Development (15 credit points)

*Assessment:* By a combination of coursework, written and oral examinations where appropriate for each course. The qualification of PG Cert in TESOL can be awarded to students who obtain 60 credits at Level 1 and/or Level 2. The qualification of PG Dip in TESOL can be awarded to students who obtain 180 credits at Level 1 and Level 2. The degree of MSc TESOL shall be awarded to students who obtain 240 credits at Level 1, 2 and 3. The degree of MSc shall not be awarded to a candidate who fails to achieve a CGS grade

of D3 or above at Level 3 (in LN5906 TESOL Focussed Teaching Portfolio or LN5908 Dissertation for MSc in TESOL), irrespective of their performance in other courses.
