The Psychology Joint Honours degree is accredited by the British Psychological Society for graduate membership provided graduates have passed all the prescribed Level 3 and 4 courses and obtained an overall degree at Lower Second Class Honours or above. Candidates who have not passed all of these courses but have enough other elements in the Grade Spectrum for the award of a Joint Honours degree shall be awarded the non-accredited Joint Honours Behavioural Studies degree.
4.	Candidates who have not passed PS 4038 but have enough other elements in the Grade Spectrum for the award of an Honours degree shall be awarded the non-accredited Behavioural Studies degree.
5.	Honours programme may only be taken by full-time study.
6.	Candidates seeking entry to the Junior Honours programme must have accumulated, by award or recognition, or been exempted from, at least 240 credit points at levels 1 and 2, including the prescribed courses required to enter programme year 3.
