In Conversation with Janice Forsyth

Oscar-winning Scottish director Kevin Macdonald has had an extraordinary career since receiving an Academy Award for his film One Day in September (1999). The 42-year old filmmaker received a BAFTA for his next film, Touching the Void (2003), before directing Forest Whitaker in an Oscarwinning performance as Idi Amin in The Last King of Scotland (2006). His latest film, the taut thriller State of Play (2009), features Russell Crowe, Rachel McAdams and Helen Mirren. He is currently completing The Eagle of the Ninth, due for release later this year, which explores the mysterious fate of a Roman legion in the mountains of Scotland.
