# TRANSFORMING THE EXPERIENCE OF STUDENTS THROUGH ASSESSMENT

#### Overview

TESTA is a tried and tested method of programmatic review, mapping assessment and feedback practices across a degree programme. TESTA was first introduced in the UK as part of a National Teaching Fellowship project in 2009. The University of Aberdeen introduced TESTA in 2022, piloting it with seven academic disciplines.
