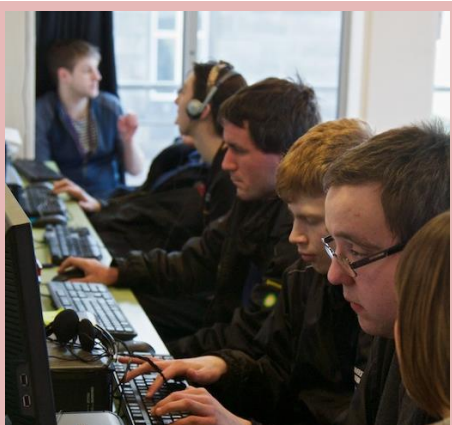


## Who are the mentors?
