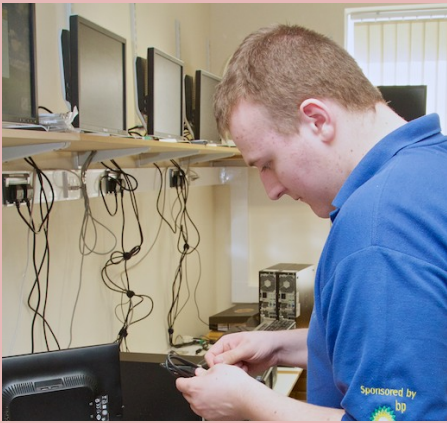


# Curriculum Support
