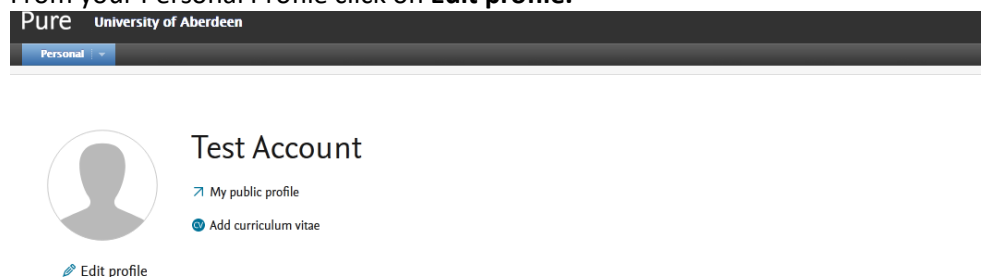


Highlighted Content in Pure

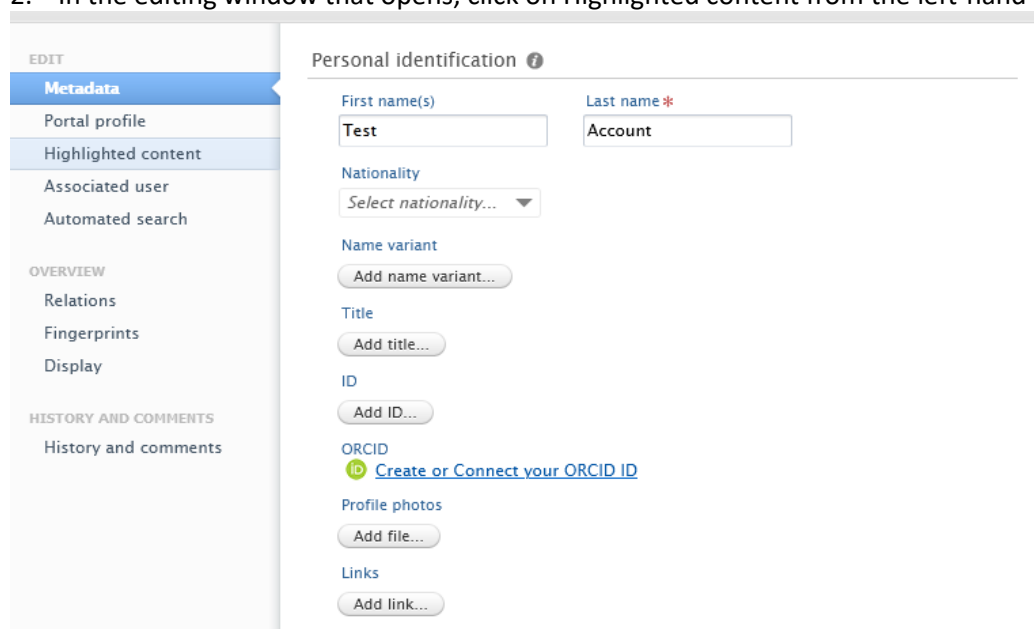
Improving visibility of Items on the Public Research Portal

1. Log into pure at: <https://pure.abdn.ac.uk/admin/>

From your Personal Profile click on **Edit profile**.



2. In the editing window that opens, click on Highlighted content from the left-hand menu.



Select the content type that you want to highlight.

You can highlight any content types that you have active in pure, however the content that will display on the Research portal are:

- Research outputs (Publications),
- Datasets,
- Activities,
- Impacts,
- Prizes, and
- Press / media

Depending on your content you may see more icons or fewer icons in the highlighted content section.


