1. Matters Arising including review of Action Log

2. Career Registration

On track for the launch of Career Readiness questions being part of the Aug/Sept 2022 Career Registration for new and returning students. Recently tested with Qatar students as part of Head of Service Tracey Inness' trip during which focus groups were conducted. Request made to the committee to share where possible the survey link with students they are engaging with to gather more data and insight.

Career Readiness questions to be for UG students only for now with PGT students to have slightly adapted questions ready for next year.

3. International Experience and Graduate Attributes & Skills Presentation

John Barrow recently gave a presentation to the 2040 UEC updating them on the work being carried out within the International Experience TFG and Graduate Attributes & Skills Working Groups. This presentation was shared with the EEC.

4. Graduate Outcome Steering Group
