

TIPS TO SAVE MONEY ON TEXTBOOKS

WAIT UNTIL YOU ARE SURE

Wait a few weeks before committing to purchasing all your books. Ask yourself how often you will use them.



BUY SECOND-HAND

- Charity Shops
- Facebook Marketplace: many local students sell their old books
- online second-hand shops (WOB, WeBuyBooks.co.uk, Abebooks, eBay, Amazon)

CHECK YOUR UNI LIBRARY

Sir Duncan Rice, Taylor Law Library, Medical Library, Divinity Library. Ask about interlibrary loans. Scanning and borrowing books is free! You can photocopy and print pages for a small price.

CHECK YOUR LOCAL LIBRARY

Register for the Aberdeen Council Library. You will be able to request books, access eBooks, listen to audio books. There even is a branch in SDRL!

CHECK ONLINE

There are great free resources online to get access to free eBooks, PDFs etc. You can often log in with your UoA credentials. *Check out: Primo, WestLaw, Open Library, Project Gutenberg, Google Scholar.*



WHEN BUYING, CHECK FOR DEALS

When buying new books, ensure that you are checking out deals. Blackwell's does Student Bundles and price-match. Amazon often offers Bundle deals. When in doubt, ask for Student Discounts!
