Semester fulfillment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Students must have completed at least 2 semesters (Undergraduate)/ 1 semester(post-graduate) or equivalent before application opens. * The official transcript uploaded must show official and final grades for these semesters. * It must be in English, signed or stamped by home university (Digital signature is accepted). * For transfer students, a minimum of one semester's result at the transferred university (current home university) is required on the official transcript.
GPA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Students must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale (B average) or ECTS C minimum or 62.5 out of 100. * For law school exchange, 3.0/4.0 or above
Language Proficiency	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - ENGLISH: If you plan to take courses taught in English, <u>TOEFL cBT 213(iBT 79, pBT 550)</u> (ITP is not accepted) <u>CEFR B2 Level</u> or <u>IELTS 6.5</u> is required. * For law school exchange, TOEFL iBT 86 or above * Native English speakers & non-native speakers studying their degree in English are waived. (If your program is fully taught in English, please upload a supporting document) * We will temporarily accept TOEFL iBT Special Home Edition as a COVID 19 alternative. - KOREAN: If you plan to take courses taught in Korean, <u>KLAT level 4</u>, or an assessment report by a professor is required. <p>Students who do not have an official test score must submit a language proficiency letter written by a faculty at their home university.</p>

Yonsei University does not offer health insurance. - Proof of health insurance must be submitted to Yonsei University. Students without health insurance will not be given access to course registration. - The proof of health insurance should include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Name of the insured ▪ Period of coverage - must be valid during visiting period ▪ Place of coverage - must be valid in Korea - All students in Korea with the student visa (D-2) will be required to purchase the Korean National Health Insurance in addition to the travel insurance. Estimated cost is 30-40 USD/month. Detail information will be provided to the students with the admission announcement.
