## Undergraduate Study

Honours programmes take four years and, whilst you are required to apply to a particular subject, the tradition at Aberdeen is to admit students to a Degree Programme such as the Master of Arts or the Bachelor of Science, rather than to a particular subject. The broad based, flexible, structure of the Aberdeen degree system means that students can choose classes from outside their main subject and can also switch to another subject (major) during the course of their studies.

## Admissions

To be considered for admission, you should present one of the following:

- High School Diploma (3.0) +
- SAT (1250+) or ACT (26+)
- For STEM Subjects or Law Plus 2 AP/SAT
- 3 AP (3) / 3 SAT (600+)

## How to Apply

Students applying from the United States for undergraduate admission to the University of Aberdeen may apply through UCAS ([www.ucas.com](http://www.ucas.com)) or the Common App ([www.commonapp.org](http://www.commonapp.org)). Please note that you may use only one method of application.

US Applicants are encouraged to apply by the January 15th deadline, though international applications are considered up until 30 June. Please note that the deadline for Medicine is October 15th.
