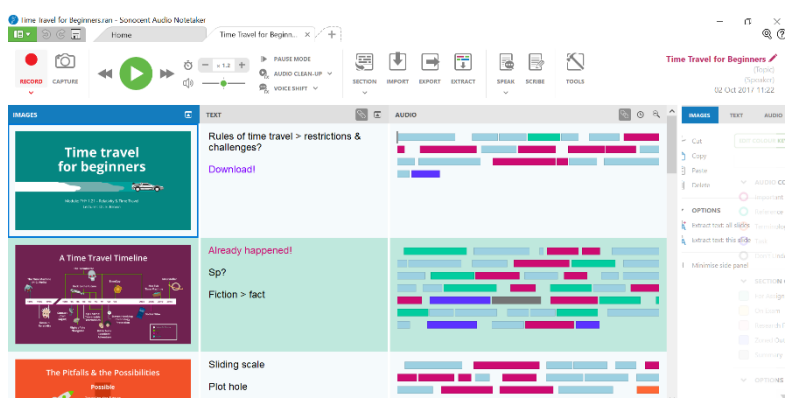


# Introduction to Audio Notetaker
